ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIPS

Each year, the S.C. International Trade Conference presents scholarships to students in memory of Mrs. Margaret A. Patrick, who was instrumental in the development of the Trade Conference and its outstanding support of transportation education, and in memory of W. Don Welch, the former executive director of the South Carolina State Ports Authority. In 2018, five scholarships were awarded, ranging from \$1,500 to \$2,500.

An applicant must be a **currently enrolled at a college or university** with a minimum 3.0 overall GPA. Applicants must also be either: (1) a S.C. resident attending any college or university (2) attending any South Carolina college or university regardless of residency (3) **major study as International Trade, Supply Chain Management or Business Degree**

The selection and ranking criteria, in order of importance, are:

- Proven interest or experience in International Trade, Supply Chain Management or Business related area, to include work or volunteer experience;
3.0 Current academic standing and performance minimum overall GPA
- Narrative and letter of recommendation; and
- Honors and extracurricular activities.

Beyond this scholarship offer, students are also invited to attend the Conference's daily business sessions at no charge. These sessions are planned to be held at the Gaillard Convention Center, Downtown Charleston. Each session will be led by professionals who are confronted daily by a variety of international trade and logistics issues.
